CHALLENGE GRANTS

Challenge Grants provide supplemental funding for instructional projects and innovative programs that might not otherwise be funded by the district due to limited financial resources.

Every district employee is eligible to apply for a grant in these four categories:

STEAM / Project Based Learning
Social Emotional / Character Development
Academic / Instructional
Professional Learning

STUDENT GRANTS

Student Enrichment Grants support opportunities that encourage Maize students to find their own versions of success and to become responsible, civically engaged adults.

Students in grades seven through 12 can apply for a grant of up to \$500 to help cover the costs associated with enrichment activities like leadership seminars, educational expeditions, national competitions and more!

STUDENT WORKSHOPS
